Financial Aid: Due to the intense nature of the program, virtually all students rely primarily on financial aid. There are a few scholarships available to students while in the program. Student Employment: Learning anesthesia is very demanding, therefore, **student employment is strongly discouraged**. Students have a full course schedule and almost all of our students find it impossible to work in addition to the program requirements. **Students should expect to spend up to 70 hours per week dedicated to fulfilling clinic responsibilities, attending classes and studying.**

If the student does not start the program or terminates from the program for any reason, voluntary or involuntary, before the beginning of their fourth semester, the deposit will be forfeited and retained by the department.
